## **Recent Nevada Graduates Will Celebrate Tesla Apprenticeship Acceptance with Signing Day**

**LAS VEGAS (June 24, 2021)**— In celebration of 11 [Jobs for Nevada's Graduates \(J4NG\)](#) students being accepted into Tesla's Manufacturing Development Program (MDP), members of the media are invited to attend an Apprenticeship Signing Day at Valley High School. J4NG, a nonprofit organization that provides guidance and college/career pathways for Nevada's high school youth, has partnered with the Tesla Gigafactory located in Reno, Nev., since 2017, connecting students to the program. 2021 graduates will become the fifth cohort of students to go through the program, with possible career pathways into Tesla upon completion of the MDP. In partnership with the apprenticeship, J4NG graduates will attend Truckee Meadows Community College (TMCC) and receive an industry recognized certification in automation and robotics. The Apprenticeship Signing Day will celebrate the students admitted into the program with an official signing of acceptance.

**WHO:** Recent J4NG graduates will be celebrated with a signing for commitment into Tesla's Manufacturing Development Program. J4NG specialists and Executive Director of J4NG, Dr. René Cantú, will be there to honor and support students who have achieved this accomplishment. Representatives from Tesla will also join the celebration to welcome students into the program. Media is invited to attend and will have opportunities for interviews with J4NG students and staff.
